Discounts - Earn a \$25 discount for each additional person you recruit for the trip. When they put your name on their registration and send their deposit, we will credit your discount on your balance due.

Reservation Policy – Your deposit (listed on front of page under specific tour) is your reservation. The balance is due 60 days before departure.

Cancellation Policy - Must be in writing. 65 days before departure - full refund. 40-64 days before departure - refund minus \$75 fee. Within 39 days, refund minus \$75 fee only if a replacement is found.
